# **TIP SHEET:** Spreading "Good Will" by Recognizing and Congratulating Members for their Contributions

A guide to why it is valuable to promote and acknowledge member contributions

Congratulating and acknowledging the achievements of our IEEE members and volunteers is one simple way to promote "good will" around the organization and bring increased visibility to IEEE. The following are tips and templates modeled after posts that delivered the best engagement and performance metrics during a social media performance test. These can be quickly customized.

# Goal:

Increasingly promote IEEE on social media platforms and create "good will" by acknowledging members who have won an award inside or outside of IEEE.

# What We Learned Worked Well:

- 1. Creating original congratulatory posts (Facebook)
- 2. Retweeting content, while congratulating accomplishments (Twitter)
- 3. Regular retweets (Twitter)
- 4. Including a strong visual
- 5. Awards posts performed better than traditional posts on Facebook

### **Example of Sample Congratulations:**

- 1. Winning an award from IEEE and/or its Societies
- 2. Winning an award from outside of IEEE
- 3. Publishing a paper
- 4. Being named an IEEE Fellow

### **Copy Templates:**
